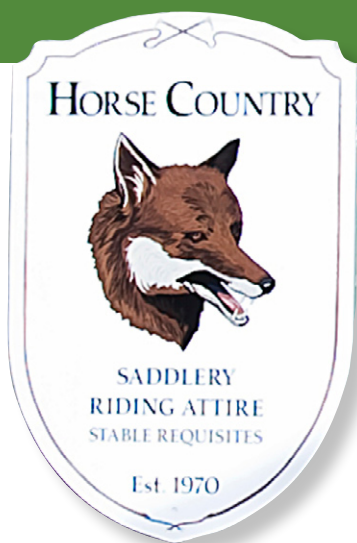


Winging it Our Way?
